2017/06/10: Environmental and village issues:

a) The Pond - Cllr Styche had contacted Burnby Gardens in Pocklington to seek advice regarding controlling the lilies. He was advised that the only effective way of control is to spray and this must be undertaken March and the end of August. Cllr Simmonds agreed to look into possible firms who might undertake this work, clerk to contact ERNLLCA regarding villages in the area who might have knowledge/information on this subject, clerk to make enquiries with chemical companies who might be able to advise. It was also suggested that the environmental agency be contacted for advice. It was agreed that the reed cutting boat is still required in September.

b) Fallen tree at churchyard: Waiting for suggested meeting dates from PCC.

c) New village matters to report: A hedge on High Street Wootton is infringing the pavement – Cllr Campbell to ask the owner to cut back.

Grass clippings are being dumped on the grass verge on Cherry lane – just past the garage.

There is a hedge on Cherry lane Wootton which is growing out into the road and needs cutting back.

The bunting on Cherry lane still has not been removed.

A resident is burning a manure heap which is disturbing neighbours – clerk to deal with this matter.

The pot hole on West End road corner (Ulceby) has still not been repaired.
