- i. Report from NLC Ferry Ward Member: Cllr Wells advised that the 20mph zone and flashing warning lights will be installed within the village this week. A discussion took place regarding the N.L.C budget meeting.

New matters to consider: The road sweeper visits the village at the same time every week – if it were to come later perhaps it would be able to sweep certain areas of the village which are never cleaned as cars are parked in a regular place – a later time slot for the sweeper may allow for some of these parked vehicles to have moved.

A RH bed warning sign – positioned on Croxton Road towards the Wold Road/Barton Road/ High Street junction has become visible now the undergrowth has been removed. It is laid on the grass verge – its needs reinstating on Croxton Road.

- b) Works to trees by N.L.C – Birtwhistles have provide a quotation to undertake the work to the trees in the churchyard which is compatible with the grant money allocated for this project. Clerk has made contact with N.L.C to arrange submission for grant payment and Birtwhistles have scheduled the works for March. Clerk

to advise PCC accordingly.

c) Community Grant – to advise Wootton PC has been awarded £150 for winter planting – to be claimed by 8/3/19. Cllr Simmonds kindly offered to purchase a new tub and compost ready to be planted up with summer bedding and situated within the village, providing a receipt for the clerk prior to 8/3/19.

d) New village matters to report: The garage in Wootton is being dismantled very carefully by developers and the demolition process is going very satisfactorily.
