Wootton Village Hall on Swallow Lane is available to hire for all occasions. It's a generous space with a raised stage, tables and chairs, making it easy to create theatre style or relaxed party layouts. A separate kitchen area with serving hatch means it's also ideal for catering events and bars. Hall hire is £40 for the first 2 hours then £10 an hour after this includes all facilities (kitchen, tables chairs etc.).

The hall is an asset to the village that requires regular support and funding. An easy way to contribute is through the Lincs Lotto. Buying a £1 ticket and linking it to Wootton Village Hall will give the hall 60p, with a 1 in 50 chance to win £25,000 these odds are better than the national lottery. The next meeting will be at 7pm on the 21<sup>st</sup> May in the school house.

At every meeting there is an opportunity for any members of the public present to make comments about the agenda items, for a maximum of 15 minutes total, prior to the commencement of the Parish Council meeting.

A parish councillor's primary role is to represent the village and the people who live in it. Your councillors meet 10 times a year and provide a bridge between this community and North Lincolnshire Council. Examples of things that the parish council responsibilities may include are; grass cutting in open spaces in the village, work carried out to the trees in the church yard, reporting faulty street lighting,

road signage, road drains, potholes, supporting installation of school safety measures, giving considered opinions to NLC on planning applications (we do not have the right to grant or refuse permission for planning, only to make local recommendations). The PC are in consultation with professional contractors in pond management. The advice is to remove lilies and cut back reed beds (reducing but not removing) prevention of bank erosion and to retain a habitat for the pond wildlife.
