2019/06/03: Adoption of the minutes of the Annual Council and Monthly Parish Council meetings held on 21st May 2019

- ii) To receive the income and expenditure sheet for the year to date indicating where expenditure is allocated during the year – circulated.

2019/06/10: Environmental and village issues:

- a) The Pond/Lily's/Maintenance – Cllr Horton had investigated ways to dispose of the waste from the pond and a waste disposal firm from Winterton Road, Scunthorpe – Ellgia – could undertake

this using skips. They will need to get a permit from N.L.C which normally takes 3 days to obtain. It would need to be confirmed that Aquatic solutions have the equipment to put the waste from the pond into the skips placed on the pond side.

Cllr Hare advised the meeting that she had spoken to Brian Plant who have the facility to load the waste from the pondside into skips and take the skips away. Cllr Hare will get a quotation from Brian Plant and advise the clerk so that the grant application can commence.

b) New village matters to report: Cllr Campbell will talk to R S Gardening about undertaking a little more work at the churchyard – namely clearing some brash and mowing along the fence line to the south of the churchyard.

A motor home appears to be parked along Cherry lane.

Unfortunately a delivery lorry to the Keigar Homes site on Cherry lane was parked inappropriately and blocked the road.

The hedge along Thornton Road – adjacent to the Nags Head needs cutting back. Clerk to try and arrange.

The grass mowing at Pocket Park has not been undertaken and is impossible to walk in this area- clerk to report to N.L.C
