Wootton Parish Council

An amended planning application has been submitted for housing on the field to the South of the High Street reference PA/2021/610 for 38 dwellings and a retail unit. Any additional Comments / Objections need to reach the North Lincolnshire Planning Committee through their online portal at North Lincolnshire Council, Business Development, Church Square House, 30-40 High Street, Scunthorpe, DN15 6NL by 30th September.

Wootton Parish Council working in conjunction with Wootton St Andrew's School children have produced and erected 11 signs around the village in reference to dog fouling as seen through a child's eye.

There have been some complaints regarding bonfires. Wherever possible, please try to use recycling for waste. If a bonfire is the best practicable option for disposing of garden waste, follow these guidelines from Environmental Protection UK to avoid causing a nuisance:

- warn your neighbours beforehand - do not light a bonfire if your neighbours are in the garden, have their washing out, or have their windows open
- only burn dry material, never burn household rubbish, rubber tyres, or anything containing plastic, foam or paint, never use old engine oil, meths or petrol to light the fire
- avoid lighting a fire in unsuitable weather conditions; smoke hangs in the air on damp, still days and in the evening and if it is windy, smoke may be blown into neighbouring gardens and across roads.
- Never leave a fire unattended & have plenty of water available to put the fire out if needed.

Parish Council meetings are held on the third Tuesday of the month at 7pm. As restrictions are still subject to changes, it is advisable to contact Karen - the clerk to the parish council at adair1@btinternet.com if you wish to attend. At every meeting there is an opportunity for any member of the public present to make comments about the agenda items, for a maximum of 15 minutes total, prior to the commencement of the parish council meeting. (You do not need to stay for the entire meeting.)
